If you are looking for accommodation you may already have visited your local authority and so you could be referred to us by them, by other agencies or you can simply approach Solo by yourself.

You could be claiming welfare benefits or in work. We will interview you, and if we think there is a good chance of matching your needs to that of the landlords on our register we'll set up a meeting. If both you and the landlord are happy with the arrangement, you can move in.

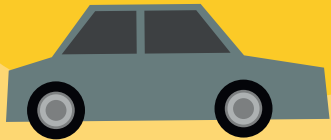
