

Solo's Supported Housing – if you are looking for supported housing, how does it work?

We have properties and support teams working in South Norfolk, Breckland, Babergh and Mid-Suffolk. You can either contact us directly or if an agency or individual is working with you, they can contact us on your behalf. We will send you an application form, which you need to complete and return. We may ask for further information once we have read your application. If you refer yourself then you will need to give us details of someone who knows about your personal circumstances and who we can approach for further information.

Once the application form and the supporting information is returned, we will assess whether your application is suitable against our criteria, and if so, arrange an interview. If all goes well, we will arrange a move in date for your new home and allocate you a Support Worker.

Our accommodation is not permanent. We expect residents to move on within two years and as part of our support package we will help you to find private sector, local authority or housing association accommodation to move into.
